NASCAR AUTHORIZED CREDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- Red Official hard card good in all garages
- OFFICIALS and NASCAR hard cards are authorized entry at all times
- Other series hard cards are authorized if running with NSCS
- Racing Radios, Sunoco, and Goodyear personnel should be allowed in the garage approximately 30 minutes prior to scheduled opening.
- Race teams are only allowed early entry with prior approval from the series director or Buster Auton.

GARAGE:

- NO alcoholic beverages.
- Photo identification required for paper credentials (if individual using the credential does not match identification take the credential and record the name, DOB and driver's license number of the individual using the credential).
- Minors entering the garage must have a NASCAR issued credential.
- Minor credential with a "HOT" sticker mirrors the parents credential.
- Minor credentials without a "HOT" sticker is valid race day only for specified series.
- <u>NO</u> GOLF CARTS ALLOWED IN THE GARAGE (NASCAR green "GATORS" are authorized, EMS and Fire if working the garage).
- OVERNIGHT SECURITY must be provided for the garage.

PRE-RACE

- When the first car is positioned on pit road, security will be in place to keep fans away from the race cars.
- Fans and tours should be kept in the concrete area on pit road.
- The only time paper credentials are authorized on pit road is when they are accompanied by a person exhibiting a NASCAR hard card.
- After the National Anthem pit road must be cleared except for crew members and broadcast media.

OUALIFYING:

- Live broadcast may have three (3) representatives outside the concrete area to conduct interviews (the first five cars in line should not be involved in interviews).
- Media and photographers are allowed in the concrete area of the pit stall behind the white line (race track side of pit wall)
- Fans are to be kept on the non-race track side of pit wall and not allowed over the wall (security must be in place on pit road to monitor this).
- Uniformed crew members should be the only personnel around the race cars.

PIT ROAD DURING THE RACE:

- When teams vacate a pit box track security should keep fans out but allow properly credentialed media, broadcast or photographers to use the empty pit box.
- During NSCS race, only "hot" credentials and hard cards are authorized to be on pit lane.
