EMERGENCY SERVICES/ FIRST AID

 - Gate 11: Skybox / Handicap / Bus Entrance

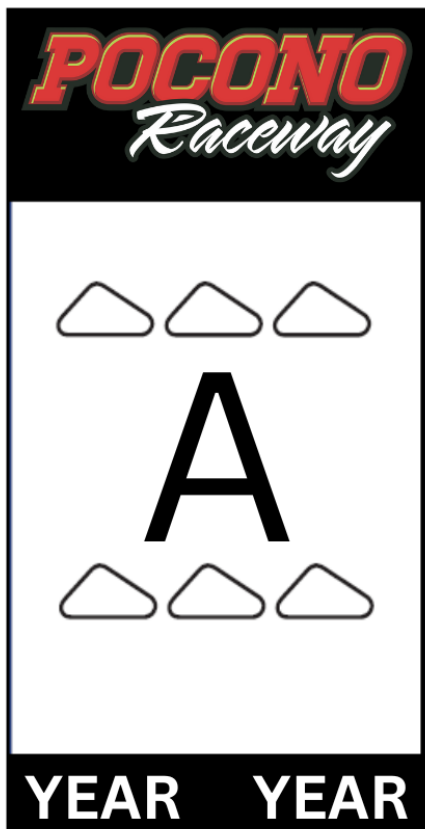

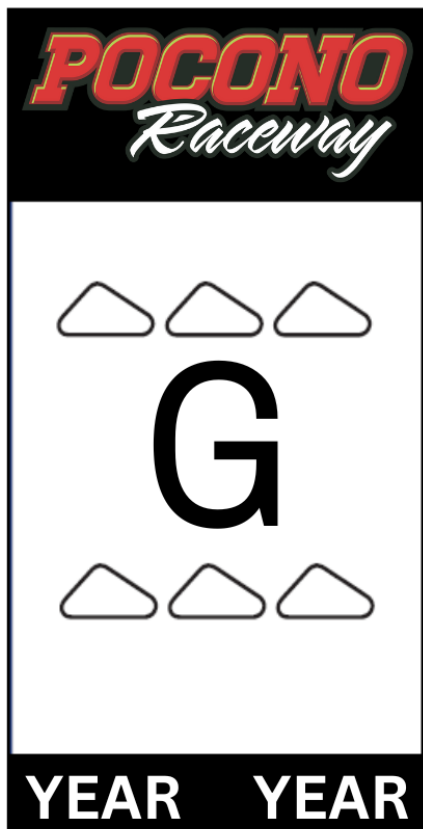

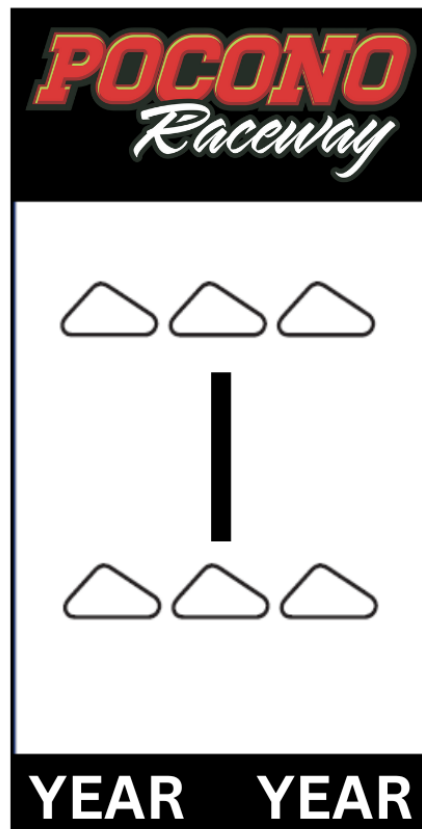

DISPLAY/ACTIVATION INFORMATION

LOAD IN/LOAD OUT SCHEDULE

- Load In/Setup: Wednesday & Thursday of event week from 8 AM to 6 PM.
- Activation Hours: Friday 12PM to One (1) hour post checkered flag, Saturday, Sunday 8AM to One (1) hour post checkered flag.
- Load Out may occur between the conclusion of the event and 5PM the following day.
- Contact your Pocono Raceway representative if you need to make other Load In/Load Out arrangements.

PLEASE NOTE: Pocono Raceway does not have a loading dock. To make arrangements for large pallet deliveries, please contact your Pocono Raceway Representative at least 24 hours prior to delivery.

SET-UP STAFF ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

- Pick up your Credential packet at the Pocono Raceway Credential Office located on Long Pond Rd. between Gates 3 & 1.
- Once you have received your credentials, proceed to Gate 5 on Long Pond Rd. to check in.
- From Gate 5, you will be directed to Gate 13A. You must have a Pocono Raceway issued Credential & Parking Pass visible to be granted entry.
- From Gate 13A, you will be guided to your specific display footprint in Fan Fair.

DAILY EVENT STAFF ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

- Enter through Gate 5 on Long Pond Rd.
- Your Event Staff Parking Pass will allow you to park in Event Staff Parking near Gate 13A. If you do not have an Event Staff Parking Pass, all General Grandstand parking is FREE.
- Proceed on foot to Fan Fair Gate 4 (FF4). Look for the Event Staff Sign on the Gate.
- Please make sure you have your access credential before attempting to gain entry

DISPLAY CREDENTIALS

- Display Worker Credentials & Parking Passes can be picked up at the Pocono Raceway Credential Office. Please see address and times above
- Credentials allow individuals entrance to the Fan Fair area to work the display during Fan Fair hours.
- Chief display workers must organize how the credentials will be distributed to display workers and temporary setup workers.

DISPLAY PARKING PASSES

- Service or Vendor Pass
 - This parking pass is to be displayed on the windshields of any vehicles entering the Fan Fair area prior to 8 AM. After 8 AM, all vehicles not part of the display must be out of the Fan Fair area.
 - NOTE: All vehicles that are part of your display must be CHEVROLET or GM products unless express permission has been granted by Pocono Raceway prior to the event.
 - Service Parking Rules:
 - Delivery/Vendor. 15 Minute Delivery Parking
 - No Permanent Parking. Additional Parking Pass needed for Reserved Parking areas.
- Event Staff Parking
 - This parking pass is to be displayed on the windshields of display worker vehicles. Valid on Grandstand Side Only in Event Staff Parking near Gate 13A

TRASH DISPOSAL & RECYCLING

- Displays must maintain a clean area around their location(s) and dispose of trash in dumpsters.
- Cardboard must be separated for recycling. Boxes must be flattened and laid next to trashcans.
- Displays failing to dispose of trash and recycling appropriately may be subject to a cleaning fee.

PREMIUMS & GIVEAWAY GUIDELINES

- Items such as hats, t-shirts, and drinking vessels must be limited as giveaways unless purchased through Pocono Raceway.
- No Track or Event logos may be used on premium artwork without Pocono Raceway approval.
- All premiums must be compliant with gate admission policy.
- All premiums must be approved by Pocono Raceway in advance.

FOOD & BEVERAGE SAMPLING GUIDELINES

- All food or beverage sampling is strictly limited to two ounces (2oz.) or less.
- All alcoholic beverage samplings are limited to two ounces (2oz.) or less by the Pennsylvania State Liquor Control Board.
- No food or beverage sales will be permitted unless granted express written permission by Pocono Raceway and its affiliate concessionaire in writing in advance of the event.

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

- All display activation requires the agency or company to secure and maintain insurance coverage with a reputable company as outlined below. Proof of this coverage must be supplied to your Pocono Raceway Representative 30 days prior to event. If unsure of requirements, please ask your Pocono Raceway representative for an example of an acceptable COI.

Golf Cart and/or Unlicensed Off-Road Vehicle Policy

- Golf Carts may be rented through your Pocono Raceway Representative while supplies last.
- Anyone renting or bringing a Golf Cart and/or Unlicensed Off-Road Vehicle on Pocono Raceway Property must provide a valid Certificate of Insurance. If unsure of our requirements, please ask your Pocono Raceway representative for an example of an acceptable COI.
- Golf Carts and/or Unlicensed Off-Road Vehicles must be registered with Pocono Raceway and must always display the Golf Carts and/or Unlicensed Off-Road Vehicles credential on the Vehicle
 - Permits will be granted for business purposes only. No personal use is allowed for any reason.
 - Vehicles must be driven by a licensed person over the age of 18.
- Physically impaired, disabled, or handicapped persons are permitted to use purpose-built, single-person electric convenience vehicles (ECV's). These vehicles will not require a registration credential.
- Violation of these regulations will result in the Golf Carts and/or Unlicensed Off-Road Vehicles being impounded for the remainder of the event weekend and possible expulsion of the operator from the property.
